TITLE: Special Waste, Oil, Oil Filters, and Oil Containers
POLICY NO: 33-05
RESCINDS: N/A

Policy Objective: To ensure that any waste materials that may have long term impact on the Commission and its facilities, are subject to environmental, engineering and regulatory due diligence before they are accepted for handling and disposal.

Policy Statement:

The Mackenzie Regional Landfill will accept Oil, Oil Containers, and Oil Filters subjected to Federal, Provincial and Municipal governing regulations in force by the Environmental Protection and Enhancement Act.

Background:

The Mackenzie Regional Landfill will accept non-contaminated Oil, Oil Containers, and Oil Filters at no charge. If the waste hauler spills oil on the landfill property they will be required to pay for all clean up costs.

Responsibilities and Authorities:

The waste hauler must inform the scale operator they are hauling Oil or Oil products. The waste hauler will be required to place the Oil products in the oil recycling facility. The landfill operator will inspect the load for compliance and contamination. The landfill operator will contact an outside company to pick up the oil products from the Landfill.
