TITLE: Special Wastes
POLICY NO: 36-05
RESCINDS: N/A

Policy Objective: To ensure that any waste materials not included in the structured waste rates, and that may have long term impact on the Commission and its facilities, are subject to environmental, engineering and regulatory due diligence before they are accepted for handling and disposal.

Policy Statement:

Any waste not described in the established rate structures will be accepted on an individual basis only and is subject to Commission Board approval.

Background:

The Commission is required to establish a Schedule of Rates to be charged to each of the participating Municipalities and/or, agencies for each tonne of waste that is deposited at the landfill site. The Schedule of Rates and Policies describes all those types of wastes that will be accepted and the disposal fee that will be charged.

Responsibilities and Authorities:

Subject to Board approval, the Manager shall establish the classifications, conditions, requirements and rates under which all waste shall be accepted from handling, processing and disposal at the waste disposal facilities.

The Manager shall bring forward to the Board for approval, all requests for acceptance of waste not described in the approved classifications and rate structure.

The Manager shall be responsible for investigating and retaining all governing regulations currently in force for all types of waste, including wastes not forming part of the approved rate structures.
